

# Comprehensive Outreach and Retention for African Americans





# Project Overview

FHHS has developed the Comprehensive Outreach and Retention Program for African-Americans (CORA). The program is designed to significantly reduce new HIV cases at our local HBCU, Stillman College, by a) linking and retaining high-risk individuals to PrEP (pre-exposure prophylaxis) and b) diagnosing, treating, and retaining all PLWH in HIV medical care and case management services, thereby maintaining viral suppression and preventing new HIV transmissions.



#### Population

Highest HIV Risk Group in the State
Approximately 50% Uninsured
Low Income
High HIV Stigma

Free STI Testing
Intensive Relationship Building
Convenient & Affordable Testing Options (Five Spot)
Affordable Treatment Options

Total Samples: 125

Male: 64 Female: 61





#### STI/ STD Sample Results

Total Samples: 125

Reactive: 30

Nonreactive: 95






#### 5-Month Referral & Linkage-to-Care Outcomes

- Linked 10 students to PrEP
- Linked 28 students to STI treatment
- Linked 5 students to
   FHHS transportation services
   for appointments at clinic.
- Facilitated 8 sexual health education sessions to over 100 students.

- Linked 2 students to our local Sexual Assault Resource Center
- Linked 4 students to primary medical care


### Implement Mental Health Screenings and Linkage to Care
